### **Introduction of face coverings for appointments**

**From Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June**, everyone using public transport or attending a hospital must wear a face covering at all times.

We will also be implementing the same policy for any of our patients attending the surgery for an appointment, of any kind, from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June.

Our clinical staff are already wearing the appropriate PPE, including surgical face masks, when consulting with patients.

In order to protect other patients and staff at the surgery, we are now asking that all patients entering the building for an appointment wear a cloth face covering.

Unfortunately, we are not able to provide face masks to patients as these are in short supply and must be reserved for our clinicians.
